Puppy Warranty and Commitments

Acceptance of the Puppy

The adopter acknowledges receiving the puppy's health, vaccinations, and deworming records, has examined the puppy to their satisfaction, and accepts it with its natural characteristics (color, mask, teeth, eyes, etc.) as well as any notes included in the health records, if applicable.

Infectious Disease and Congenital Disorder Warranty

A refund warranty is offered if the puppy dies within 30 days after pickup from an infectious disease, or within its first 24 months of life from a congenital disorder. To qualify, written confirmation of the cause of death from a veterinarian along with an autopsy report must be provided, all associated costs are the responsibility of the adopter. The microchip number must appear on all documents submitted to the breeder.

Exclusion of Warranty

Due to the unpredictable nature of genetics, the breeder cannot be held responsible for cryptorchidism, complete or unilateral (absence of one or both testicles in males), the final number of teeth, or the adult coat color.

Non-Breeding Clause

The adopted puppy is intended solely as a companion animal. Any breeding, intentional or not, is strictly prohibited without the breeder's prior written authorization. The breeder does not require proof of sterilization, but reserves the right to take action if this clause is not respected.

Breeder Commitment

The breeder commits to raising puppies with care, in an environment that supports their physical, emotional, and social well-being; ensuring necessary veterinary care before departure and providing all corresponding health documents. Parents are selected based on temperament and health to ensure the puppy's genetic foundation. As these are companion dogs and not registered, their heritage may include other breeds. Future development depends on the education, socialization, and environment provided by the adopter. The breeder remains available for guidance and general support without replacing professional veterinary or canine behavioral services.

Adopter Commitment

Adopting a puppy represents a long-term commitment requiring time, consistency, and financial and emotional resources. The adopter acknowledges that the puppy is in development and that normal behaviors (fears, clumsiness, house-training, nipping, reactions or anxiety) may appear during growth. The adopter commits to providing education, socialization, and guidance, and to promptly consult a certified dog trainer or behavior professional promptly if difficulties arise, following their recommendations in good faith. If the adopter cannot keep their dog, they agree to prioritize the puppy's well-being by placing it within their immediate family, a close circle, or a stable environment. If no suitable solution exists, the breeder is available to assist in finding a responsible alternative. The breeder may take the dog if its well-being can be ensured, though timing may depend on available capacity. The breeder has no obligation to take back a dog presenting a safety risk. In the event of a return, no refund will be provided, however, no fees will be required.

Breeder's Note

Each puppy is raised with attention and dedication until departure. These warranty clauses aim to establish a clear and fair framework of responsibilities to prevent misunderstandings and ensure a transparent, healthy and respectful relationship. We consider each adoption unique and precious, and placing one of our puppies in a loving home is a privilege we never take lightly. We sincerely thank our adopters for their trust and for the love they will provide to their companion throughout its life.
